

COVID-19 Vaccination Options for those 65+ or under 64 with medical conditions



Hospitals

The University of Iowa Hospitals & Clinics and Mercy Iowa City are contacting patients directly at this time through mychart/email or phone. If you have used a provider through either system in the past two years, you will fall into the group they are vaccinating.

Complete a short form on the UIHC and Mercy Iowa City websites to express interest in receiving the vaccine, even if you are not a patient. **When you are eligible and doses are available, the hospitals will contact you to schedule your appointment.**
