 - Provides rides for residents who are unable to utilize public transportation to transport to doctors' appointments, grocery stores, and other destinations due to a documented disability
 - Eligibility: Must fill out an application form to turn into the Johnson County Transit division. Applications can be obtained by calling 319-356-5151 for Iowa City residents or 319-337-6900 for University Heights residents
